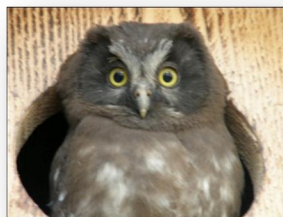
people. Therefore there is no bar at Oivanki, we are a non-toxicant area. Keep that in mind, please. 😊
