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WHAT DOES THE NUMBER MEAN?

- (1) Each country organizes an evening program, one at a time. Cultural evenings are meant to get to know each of the participants' countries (Finland, Spain, Czech, Estonia and Slovenia). **Evenings can include almost anything; typical games to your country, dancing or a play or different arts, cooking, even quizzes and language schools are welcome.** ;) Evening can include anything that groups want to present from their culture and their country to the others. **All groups could bring a movie from their country, which presents the lifestyle of young people in their country.** Movies can be watched in cultural evening and after the movie we are going to have feedback conversation all together.
- (2) Getting to know each other by **games**, trust practices and funny activities.
- (3) Every day is organised a **short meeting in national groups, in which the feelings of the days are reflected.** Supervisors will inform at same time about the following programs. We have a possibility to handle the possible problems and questions and making a follow up of the experiences & learning during the camp.
- (4) Five persons per group make a short play from a different participant culture and country than the participants of the group are. **The task is to do a short play from the culture and manners in introduction country. Funny plays might be offensive to some of the people in the camp, but participants must notice that this is one way to learn some things about other persons, do not take it too seriously. Main thing is to recognize these plays as a part of the camps international goals, to learn by mistakes and making an effort to make it alright again.** Plays also reveal campers prejudices and stereotypes from other camp members, which are now open to the conversation. Feedback in order!
- (5) Three persons per group and every group are international. The groups are talking about important matter for youth, friendship, family, hobbies etc.. Topics are international; like **youth employment and unemployment, immigration question, racism and discrimination, European, tolerance. Consideration, how different topic and problem show in different country, compare those and do summaries** from an each topic, which are then used as workshop topics. For example **public action group** can have to make comics from the topic name youth unemployment.
- (6) **The Art workshops:** We will produce performances, so that we can show as our result from this camp to the public. The materials will be collected during the camp. There can be one, or several of them. The main topics will be:
 - **Music workshops:** bring your own musical ideas, this can be playing in a band, making your own rap-music or other. the idea is to play together and make new music from materials all around Europe! We are also interested to hear some ethnic-musical elements from your area!
 - **Dance workshops:** you can bring in the dance . styles from your area. We can get together styles from different parts of Europe. And a common message, too.
 - **Drama – Make your own stories & bring them to the public**
 - **Production, management, promotion / Media/ Public action**
 - We will produce material and make a European newspaper that can be read in every country. Also we take care of the local promotion and organise the performances!
 - *Visibility and marketing*
 - *Photography*
 - *Visual arts*
