

GET IN TOUCH Training Course on methods to be used in (international) youth work

Once we know when you arrive we will inform you about train connections. For the train trip from the airport to Götzis you have to calculate about € 50,-.

The nearest train stations are Götzis and Feldkirch. Pick up will be organised from Götzis and Feldkirch.
